

## MDE PROGRAM ADVISORY

**Date:** 21 May 2013

**Subject:** Regular schedule of MDE course offerings beginning SY 2013-14

This is to advise you that starting SY 2013-2014, DE courses will be offered according to the following schedule:

<b>First semester courses</b> (corresponding to courses prescribed for the 1 <sup>st</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> semesters of a study program)	<b>Second semester courses</b> (corresponding to courses prescribed for the 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> semesters of a study program)
Economic Analysis I (DE 201) Economic Analysis II (DE 202) Quantitative Analysis I (DE 206) Growth, Poverty and Development (DE 291) Research Seminar (Econ 299)  <i>Any two of the three:</i> Local Public Economics (DE 252) Trade and Development Policy (DE 241) Institutional and Policy Analysis (DE 293)  Econ 300	Economic Analysis II (DE 202) Quantitative Analysis II (DE 231) Public Finance (DE 251) Project Analysis and Evaluation (DE 253) Program Evaluation (DE 292)      Econ 300

This schedule of courses is consistent with the suggested ordering of subjects for both full-time and part-time study, with two adjustments (see Attachment):

1. For the full-time study program, DE 202 should now be taken in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and DE 231 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester.
2. For the part-time thesis track program, coursework for the 4<sup>th</sup> semester will now be identical to 4<sup>th</sup> semester of the part-time non-thesis track program, i.e. DE 251, DE 253 and DE 292. For the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, only DE 291 is prescribed.

It is important that you are guided by the above schedule in your decisions to enrol and/or drop henceforth. Specifically, if you forego taking (or completing) a subject when it is scheduled, you will have to wait a year for another opportunity to enrol or re-take the class (with the exception of DE 202 which will be offered every semester).
